

RURAL BANK (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 5, 1946.

An Act to amend certain provisions relating to advances for homes contained in the Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 7th January, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Rural Bank (Amendment) Act, 1945." Short title.

2. The Government Savings Bank Amendment Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended— Amendment of Act No. 13, 1913. Sec. 3 (3).

- (a) by omitting from subsection three of section three the words "one thousand two hundred pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand eight hundred pounds"; (Limits of advances.)
- (b) by omitting from the same subsection the word "three-fourths" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "four-fifths."
