

NURSES REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

An Act to make provision for the appointment of an additional member to the Nurses Registration Board; for this purpose to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1953; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th March 1955.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Nurses Registration (Amendment) Act, 1955."

(2) The Nurses Registration Act, 1953, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Nurses Registration Act, 1953-1955.

2. (1) The Nurses Registration Act, 1953, is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection one of section five the word “thirteen” and by inserting in lieu thereof the word “fourteen”;

(b) by omitting from paragraph (i) of the same subsection the words “one shall be a person” and by inserting in lieu thereof the words “two shall be persons”.

(2) Upon the appointment of the additional member of the Nurses Registration Board pursuant to subsection one of section five of the Nurses Registration Act, 1953, as amended by subsection one of this section, the Nurses Registration Board, as so added to, shall, for the purposes of the said Act, as so amended, be deemed to be “the Board first constituted under this Act” referred to in the said section five.
