**JUSTICES ACT 1902 - REGULATION**

The Justices (Short Descriptions of Motor Traffic and Other Offences) Regulation 1986 is amended by inserting in Schedule 1 under the heading "Local Government Act 1919" in Columns 1 and 2, respectively, in appropriate numerical order, the following matter:

Section 269A (15) (b) - in using a vehicle on a public road, without lawful excuse fail to comply with a direction, condition or limitation specified in a notice on or in the immediate vicinity of a public road	fail to comply with notice erected on or near public road
Section 269A (15) (b) - in using a vehicle on a public road, without lawful excuse contravene a direction, condition or limitation specified in a notice on or in the immediate vicinity of a public road	contravene notice erected on or near public road

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Justices (Short Descriptions of Motor Traffic and Other Offences) Regulation 1986 to prescribe short descriptions for certain offences under the Local Government Act 1919 relating to the contravention of notices regulating traffic.
