



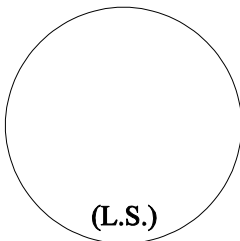

Legal Profession Amendment Act 1998 No 101—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Legal Profession Amendment Act 1998*. The provisions concerned are:

- (a) Schedule 1 [6], [7] and [8] (which amend section 61 of the *Legal Profession Act 1987* (Money received by solicitor on behalf of another)), and
- (b) so much of Schedule 1 [10] as would insert section 69E (Agreements relating to the payment of interest on general trust accounts) into the *Legal Profession Act 1987*.
