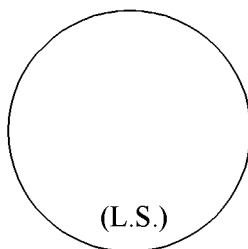

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Civil Liability Amendment (Personal Responsibility) Act 2002* so as to enable contracts for the provision of recreational services to exclude certain liabilities and so as to enable structured settlements to be entered into in relation to the payment of certain awards of damages.
