# Children's Court Amendment Bill 2000

## Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

### Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Children's Court Act 1987* to enable rules to be made conferring functions of the Children's Court or Children's Magistrates under the *Children and Young Persons (Care and Protection) Act 1998*, and related functions under the *Children's Court Act 1987*, on Children's Registrars.

## Outline of provisions

**Clause 1** sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for the commencement of the proposed Act immediately after the commencement of Schedule 1 [7] to the *Children and Young Persons Legislation (Repeal and Amendment) Act 1998*. That provision inserts proposed section 10A into the *Children's Court Act 1987* which provides for the appointment of Children's Registrars.

**Clause 3** is a formal provision giving effect to the amendment to the *Children's Court Act 1987* set out in Schedule 1.
