## PARLIAMENTARY ALLOWANCES AND SALARIES ACT.

## Act No. 6, 1925.

An Act to make further provision with regard to George V, the allowance to members of the Legislative Assembly and the salaries of Ministers of the Crown and of certain other persons; to amend the Constitution Act, 1902, and certain other Acts; to repeal the Ministers' Salaries Act, 1907; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st October, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Short title, interpretation, and commence-me it. Allowances and Salaries Act, 1925."

- (2) The Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.
- 2. The Principal Act is amended by omitting from Amendment section twenty-eight the words "six hundred" and by of Act No. 32, 1902, s. 28. inserting in lieu thereof the words "eight hundred and seventy-five."

  - (c) by omitting from the said Third Schedule the figures "12,250 0 0," and by inserting in lieu thereof the figures "13,195 0 0."
