CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 1, 1936.

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Amend- short title." ment) Act, 1936."

31A. (1) During the absence from New South Absence of Wales of the Speaker the Chairman of Committees Speaker from New, of the Legislative Assembly shall act in his place, South and for all purposes, whether of this Act or otherwise, shall have and may exercise and perform all the powers, authorities, duties and functions of the Speaker.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection one of this section the Chairman of Committees of the Legislative Assembly, while acting in the place of the Speaker under that subsection, shall be deemed to be the Speaker for the purposes of section seventy-one of the Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act, 1912-1935.
