- (d) The persons who upon the day appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette pursuant to subsection three of section two of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation (Amendment) Act, 1959, are trustees of the land described in the Third Schedule to this Act, shall be trustees of the land described in the Fourth Schedule to this Act and shall be deemed to have been so appointed pursuant to section twenty-six of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts.
