Act No 12, 2011

An Act to amend the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002* in relation to move on directions to intoxicated persons in public places. [Assented to 7 June 2011]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Amendment (Move On Directions) Act 2011*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

Section 198 Move on directions to intoxicated persons in public places

Omit “in a group of 3 or more intoxicated persons” from section 198 (1).
