
Marine Safety Act 1998 No 121

JAMES JACOB SPIGELMAN, Lieutenant-Governor

I, the Honourable James Jacob Spigelman AC, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 August 2008 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Part 2, Division 1 of Part 5, Part 7, Division 4 of Part 8 and section 144,
- (b) sections 142 and 143 to the extent to which those provisions are uncommenced,
- (c) Schedule 3.6 [1],
- (d) Schedule 3.7 [1] and [14],
- (e) clause 5 of Schedule 4.
