Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Registration of Interests in Goods Regulation* 2004 to increase certain fees payable under the *Registration of Interests in Goods Act* 1986. The fee increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index (rounded to the nearest 5 cents).

This Regulation is made under the *Registration of Interests in Goods Act 1986*, including sections 5, 6, 8 and 21 (the general regulation-making power).
