Explanatory note

The object of this Rule is to amend the District Court Rules 1973:

- (a) to omit Part 28C (Court appointed referral for legal assistance) from the Rules as a consequence of provisions to the same effect being included in the *Uniform Civil Procedure Rules 2005*, and
- (b) to provide that the Judicial Registrar of the Court may exercise the powers of the Court under rule 6, 7 or 10F of Part 53 of the Rules and under the *Bail Act 1978*.
