Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide that medical practitioners who are Fellows of the College of Intensive Care Medicine of Australia and New Zealand may be appointed as designated specialists for the purposes of the *Human Tissue Act 1983*.

This Regulation is made under the *Human Tissue Act 1983*, including sections 5 and 39 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
