Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe persons employed in the Roads and Maritime Services Division of the Government Service as persons to whom functions under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990* may be delegated.

This Regulation is made under the *Passenger Transport Act 1990*, including sections 62A and 63 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Passenger Transport Amendment (Authorised Persons) Regulation 2011.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the commencement of Schedule 1 [22] to the *Transport Legislation Amendment Act 2011* and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Amendment of Passenger Transport Regulation 2007

Clause 239A
