Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to apply certain provisions in relation to the staff of the Central Coast Water Corporation that are based on provisions in the *Local Government Act 1993*, as required by section 15 (3) (b) of the *Central Coast Water Corporation Act 2006*.

This Regulation is made under the *Central Coast Water Corporation Act 2006*, including sections 15 (3) (b) and 60 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in Schedule 3 to the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely matters of a machinery nature.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Central Coast Water Corporation Regulation 2011*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 25 February 2011 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definitions

- (1) In this Regulation:
the Act means the *Central Coast Water Corporation Act 2006*.
- (2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

4 Mandatory staff provisions: section 15 (3) (b) of Act

For the purposes of section 15 (3) (b) of the Act, the provisions of Part 4 of Chapter 11, and sections 348–350, of the *Local Government Act 1993* apply in relation to the staff of the Corporation as if:

- (a) those provisions formed part of this Regulation, and
- (b) any reference in those provisions to a council, the council or councils were a reference to the Corporation, and
- (c) any reference in those provisions to senior staff were a reference to the chief executive officer of the Corporation, and
- (d) any reference in those provisions to the Minister were a reference to the Minister administering the *Central Coast Water Corporation Act 2006*.
