Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the following:

- (a) amendments to the *Companion Animals Act 1998* that increase the maximum penalty for the offences of denying entry to an assistance animal or unlawfully imposing a charge for entry of an assistance animal;
- (b) amendments to the *Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1979* that:
 - (i) update the name of a Department, and
 - (ii) extend the power of courts hearing criminal proceedings for animal cruelty offences, and certain other offences, to make orders requiring the accused person to reimburse certain costs, and
 - (iii) authorise courts to disqualify persons convicted of animal cruelty offences from keeping, or participating in keeping, animals in the future, and
 - (iv) extend the operation of those amendments to criminal proceedings that are underway.
