Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Life Without Barriers in the list of employers in the *State Authorities Superannuation Act 1987*, Schedule 1.

As a result, those persons who, immediately before commencing employment with Life Without Barriers, were employees of Australian Unity Home Care Service Pty Ltd and were contributors to the State Authorities Superannuation Fund may continue to be contributors to the Fund for the purposes of the Act.

This Order is made under the *State Authorities Superannuation Act 1987*, section 46(1)(a), a Henry VIII provision.

Insert at the end of Part 1—

Life Without Barriers, limited to those persons—

- (a) whose employment was transferred from Australian Unity Home Care Service Pty Ltd to Life Without Barriers on 12 December 2022, and
- (b) who, immediately before the transfer, were contributors to the Fund.
