1 Name of Policy

This Policy is *State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) Amendment (Inland Rail—Narrabri to North Star Project) 2019*.

2 Commencement

This Policy commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Repeal of Policy

- (1) This Policy is repealed on the day following the day on which this Policy commences.
- (2) The repeal of this Policy does not, because of the operation of sections 5 (6) and 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Policy.

Schedule 1 Amendment of State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development) 2011

Schedule 5 Critical State significant infrastructure

Insert after clause 7 (4):

- (5) In this clause, *development*, in relation to the Narrabri to North Star project, does not include the following activities carried out before the commencement of construction in that project:
 - (a) the delivery or storage of tracks, sleepers, ballast, posts or culverts within the existing rail corridor,
 - (b) if existing water flows within or through the existing rail corridor will not be permanently affected—the adjustment, relocation, upgrade or replacement of existing utilities infrastructure.
