Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) 2020* in relation to persons entering New South Wales who have transited through Victoria from a State or Territory other than Victoria, and in relation to persons transiting through New South Wales by road.

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1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) Amendment Order 2020*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences at the beginning of 16 October 2020.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Order (No 2) 2020

[1] Clause 3 Definitions

Omit “Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Map (No 4)” from the definition of *border region* in clause 3(1) and from the note to the definition.

Insert instead “Public Health (COVID-19 Border Control) Map (No 5)”, respectively.

[2] Clause 3(1)

Insert in alphabetical order—

private health facility has the same meaning as in the *Private Health Facilities Act 2007*.

public hospital has the same meaning as in the *Health Services Act 1997*.

residential aged care facility has the same meaning as in the *Public Health (COVID-19 Aged Care Facilities) Order (No 3) 2020*.

South Australia means the geographical area of the State of South Australia.

[3] Clause 5 Direction of Minister not to enter New South Wales

Omit “8 or 15 of Schedule 1” from clause 5(4).

Insert instead “8, 15 or 19 of Schedule 1, or item 18 of Schedule 1 if the person enters New South Wales by air,”.

[4] Schedule 1 Authority to enter New South Wales

Insert after item 16—

17	A person who is entering New South Wales by road and who has transited in Victoria after leaving South Australia by road	Required	The person must— (a) transit through Victoria only via the Sturt Highway, and (b) enter New South Wales only at George Chaffey Bridge, Sturt Highway, Mildura, and (c) travel by private vehicle only
			The person must not enter New South Wales if the person has, within the previous 14 days, been in Victoria other than while transiting in Victoria via the Sturt Highway

- 18 A person who has transited in Victoria after being a passenger on the vessel known as the Spirit of Tasmania Required
- If the person enters New South Wales by air, the person must—
- (a) travel from the vessel by the most practicable direct route to an airport in Victoria, and
 - (b) not leave the airport terminal in Victoria except to board a flight to Sydney, and
 - (c) travel to New South Wales by aircraft landing at Sydney Airport, and
 - (d) have documentary evidence of the person's flight from Victoria to Sydney
- If the person enters New South Wales by road, the person must—
- (a) travel by the most practicable direct route from the vessel to New South Wales, and
 - (b) enter New South Wales only via the Hume Highway at Albury or the Newell Highway at Tocumwal
- If the person enters New South Wales by rail, the person must travel by the most practicable direct route from the vessel to New South Wales
- Despite any provision of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Aged Care Facilities) Order (No 3) 2020*, the person must not, until the period of 14 days has elapsed since the person entered New South Wales, enter or remain in a residential aged care facility unless the person is a resident of the facility
- The person must not, until the period of 14 days has elapsed since the person entered New South Wales, enter or remain in a public hospital or private health facility unless the person is seeking treatment at the hospital or facility
