1 Name of Order

2 Amendment of Public Health (COVID-19 Restrictions on Gathering and Movement) Order (No 7) 2020

(1) Clause 3 Definitions

Insert in alphabetical order in clause 3(1)—

COVID-19 concerns notice means a notice, as in force for the time being, published for the purposes of this Order by the Chief Health Officer on the New South Wales Government website specifying areas, whether or not in New South Wales, that are areas of concern for COVID-19 transmission.

(2) Clause 20A Definitions

Omit the definition of ***COVID-19 concerns notice***.

(3) Clause 20H Relationship of Division with other directions of Minister

Omit clause 20H(1).
