Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable hotels and clubs in the Newcastle local government area to trade until midnight on Sunday 25 November 2018 (being the day on which the Newcastle 500 motor race is held).

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 2007*, including sections 13 and 159 (the general regulation-making power).
