

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Retirement Villages Amendment Act 2018* that amend the *Retirement Villages Act 1999*:

- (a) to enable the regulations:
 - (i) to prescribe rules of conduct for retirement village operators, and
 - (ii) to provide for the provision, sharing and publication of certain information about retirement villages, and
 - (iii) to provide for the mediation of disputes arising under the Retirement Villages Act 1999, and
- (b) to make related and consequential amendments.
