

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all uncommenced provisions of the *Residential Tenancies Amendment (Review) Act 2018*. The only provisions of that Act that have commenced relate to—

- (a) the termination of residential tenancy agreements in circumstances of domestic violence, and
- (b) the liability of tenants for damage to premises that occurs during the commission of domestic violence offences, and
- (c) restrictions on the inclusion of personal information about tenants who are victims of domestic violence on residential tenancy databases.
