Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to clarify that recognised competency cards may be issued in hard copy or in electronic form, and to update the formula for the automatic indexation of fees to enable indexation to commence in the 2020–21 fee year.

This Regulation is made under the *Gaming Machines Act 2001*, including section 210 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Gaming Machines Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2020.
