LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT.

Act No. 13, 1929.

An Act to amend the definition of newspaper appearing in the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts.

[Assented to, 8th April, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Amendment) Act, 1929."
- Sec. 4. (Definition of newspaper.)

 2. The Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, is further amended by omitting from section four the definition of "Newspaper" and by inserting in lieu thereof the following definition:—
 - "Newspaper" means a newspaper upon which is printed a statement that it is registered for transmission by post or under the Newspapers Act, 1898, and which circulates within the area or district with respect to which the term is used.
