An Act to amend the provisions of the Main Roads Elizabeth II, No. 3, 1959. Act, 1924, and the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts, relating to proceedings for certain offences under those Acts, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th September, 1959.]

(2) The Main Roads Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Main Roads Act, 1924-1959.
