LOCAL GOVERNMENT (PAYMENT OF FEES) AMENDMENT ACT.

Act No. 33, 1963.

An Act to make provisions with respect to the payment Elizabeth II, of fees to members of councils; for this and other No. 33, 1963 purposes to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd October, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Local Government Short title (Payment of Fees) Amendment Act, 1963".

- (2) This Act shall commence on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
- 2. The Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by Amendment subsequent Acts, is amended by inserting next after section of Act No. 41, 1919. twenty-nine the following new section: -New sec. 29a.
 - 29A. (1) The council may pay to its members such Payment of fees as it may fix from time to timefees to members.

- (b) for carrying out inspections within the area, provided such inspections are undertaken in compliance with resolutions of the council; and
- (c) for undertaking business of the council outside the area in compliance with a resolution of the council.
- (2) No fees paid or payable to any one member shall in any year exceed in the aggregate two hundred and fifty pounds.
- (3) This section shall not be construed so as to affect any allowance payable under section twenty-nine of this Act.
