Act No. 44, 1970.

An Act to resolve a doubt as to the method of assessing the amount of annual holiday pay due to workers; for this purpose to amend the Annual Holidays Act, 1944; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th October, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Annual Holidays (Amendment) Act, 1970".

2. The Annual Holidays Act, 1944, is amended—
- (a) by inserting in subsection three of section two after the symbols “(a1)” the word and symbols “or (a2)”;
- (b) by omitting from the same subsection the words “and based on age or years of service”;
- (c) by omitting from the same subsection the words “for his age or years of service”.
