Act No. 45, 1970.

An Act relating to the Camperdown Memorial Rest Park and the Camperdown Memorial Rest Park Trust; for this purpose to amend the Camperdown Cemetery Act, 1948; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th October, 1970.]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Camperdown Cemetery (Amendment) Act, 1970".

 - (2) In this Act "local government area" has the meaning ascribed to that expression in the Local Government Act, 1919.
- (b) (i) by omitting from section 4A the words "the Sec. 4A.

 - (7) (a) A person who, immediately before the commencement of the Camperdown Cemetery (Amendment) Act, 1970, held office as a member of the Trust appointed under paragraph (c) of subsection two of this section shall, at that commencement, be deemed to have been appointed as a member of the Trust by the Council of the local government area in which the land described in the First Schedule to this Act is situated at that commencement.
 - (b) Where, after the commencement of the Camperdown Cemetery (Amendment) Act, 1970, the land described in the First Schedule to this Act becomes part of a different local government area, a person who, immediately before the day upon which that land became part of that area, held office as a member of the Trust appointed under paragraph (c) of subsection two of this section, shall, upon that day, be deemed to have been appointed as a member of the Trust by the Council of that area. (Power of Council to improve Park.)

- (c) (i) by omitting from section 4F the words "the City of Sydney" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "the local government area in which the land described in the First Schedule to this Act is for the time being situated";
 - (ii) by omitting from the same section the words "the land described in the First Schedule to this Act" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "that land";
 - (iii) by inserting at the end of the same section the following new subsection:—
 - (2) Where, after the Council of the local government area in which the land referred to in subsection one of this section is situated provides moneys to the Trust under that subsection, that land becomes part of a different local government area the Council of the last-mentioned area may—
 - (a) vary or revoke any terms and conditions imposed by the first-mentioned Council in so far as they have effect in respect of any unexpended portion of those moneys; or
 - (b) impose such terms and conditions as it thinks fit in respect of the expenditure of any unexpended portion of those moneys on such improvement and embellishment as is referred to in that subsection.
