Act No. 55, 1973.

An Act to make further provisions with respect to the payment of fees and allowances to members of the Mine Subsidence Board and the Mines Rescue Board; to authorise certain additional expenditure from the Mine Subsidence Compensation Fund; to validate certain matters; for these and other purposes to amend the Mine Subsidence Compensation Act, 1961, and the Mines Rescue Act, 1925; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 8th October, 1973.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by No. 55, 1973 and with the advice and some line of the second seco and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: ---

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Mine Subsidence Com-Short title. pensation and Mines Rescue (Amendment) Act, 1973".
- 2. (1) This Act, section 3 (b) excepted, commences on Commencethe date of assent.
- (2) Section 3 (b) shall be deemed to have commenced on 11th May, 1965.
- 3. The Mine Subsidence Compensation Act, 1961, is Amendment amended-
 - (a) by omitting section 5 (10) and by inserting instead Sec. 5. the following subsections:—

(Appointment and constitution

- (10) Subject to subsection (11), a member of of the Board.) the Board, other than an officer of the Public Service appointed to the Board in his capacity as such, shall be entitled to receive such fees for service as a member of the Board as the Minister may determine in respect of him.
- (11) If the Minister so orders, the fees which a member of the Board would, but for this subsection, be entitled to receive shall be paid to the employer, specified in the order, of the member instead of being paid to the member.

(12) A member of the Board shall be entitled to receive such travelling and sustenance allowances as the Minister may determine in respect of him.

Sec. 10. (Mine Subsidence Compensation Fund.)

(b) by inserting in section 10 (3) (b) after the word "Act" the words ", including expenses incurred in connection with the investigation of notifications of damage and claims for payment of compensation";

Sec. 18. (Regulations.)

- (c) by omitting section 18 (2) and by inserting instead the following subsection:—
 - (2) Section 41 of the Interpretation Act, 1897, applies in respect of a regulation as if this Act had been passed after the commencement of the Interpretation (Amendment) Act, 1969.

Amendment of Act No. 3, 1925. Subst. sec. 4E. Fees and allowances to Board members.

- 4. The Mines Rescue Act, 1925, is amended by omitting section 4E and by inserting instead the following section:—
 - 4E. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a member of the Board, other than the chairman, shall be entitled to receive such fees for service as a member of the Board as the Minister may determine in respect of him.
 - (2) If the Minister so orders, the fees which a member of the Board would, but for this subsection, be entitled to receive shall be paid to the employer, specified in the order, of the member instead of being paid to the member.
 - (3) A member of the Board shall be entitled to receive such travelling and sustenance allowances as the Minister may determine in respect of him.
