Act No. 47, 1980.

An Act to amend the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, consequent on the enactment of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980. [Assented to, 28th April, 1980.] Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Appeal Tribunal) Amendment Act, 1980".
- Commence 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
 - (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act, 1980.

 3. The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, amended—
- Sch. 2. (a) by omitting from Part 1 of Schedule 2 the words "Senior Chairman of Promotions Appeal Tribunals." and by inserting instead the words "Chairman of the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal (not being the holder of a judicial office or a magisterial office).";
- Sch. 3. (b) by omitting from Part 2 of Schedule 3 the words "Chairman of Promotions Appeal Tribunals, other than the Senior Chairman.";
- Sch. 4. (c) by omitting from Schedule 4 the words "Chairman of the Crown Employees Appeal Board.";
