#### 1 Name of Plan

This Plan is Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2014 (Amendment No 6).

#### 2 Commencement

This Plan commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

#### 3 Land to which Plan applies

This Plan applies to the land to which *Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2014* applies.

#### 4 Maps

The maps adopted by *Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2014* are amended or replaced, as the case requires, by the maps approved by the Minister on the making of this Plan.

### 5 Amendment of Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 2014

### Clause 7.3 Flood planning

Omit the definition of *flood planning level* from clause 7.3 (6). Insert instead:

#### flood planning level means:

- (a) in areas where flooding is affected by ocean water levels—the level of a 1% AEP (annual exceedance probability) flood event estimated using an ocean water level 0.9 metres above the 1990 mean sea level, plus a 0.5 metre freeboard, or
- (b) in all other areas—the level of a 1% AEP (annual exceedance probability) flood event plus a 0.5 metre freeboard.
