#### 1 Name of plan

This plan is Sydney Local Environmental Plan 2012 (Amendment No 101).

#### 2 Commencement

# Schedule 1 Amendment of Sydney Local Environmental Plan 2012

#### [1] Clause 4.6 Exceptions to development standards

Insert after clause 4.6(8)(co)-

(cp) clause 6.60I—85–93 Commonwealth Street, Surry Hills.

#### [2] Clause 6.60I

Insert after clause 6.60H-

#### 6.60I 85–93 Commonwealth Street, Surry Hills

- (1) This clause applies to Lots 22 and 23, DP 6380, 85–93 Commonwealth Street, Surry Hills.
- (2) A building on land to which this clause applies may have—
  - (a) a floor space ratio of up to 4.5:1, and
  - (b) a building height of up to the maximum height shown for the land on the Alternative Height of Buildings Map.
- (3) Subclause (2) does not apply unless the consent authority is satisfied the building will not be used for the purposes of residential accommodation or serviced apartments.
- (4) This clause does not apply to the erection of a new building on land to which this clause applies.
- (5) Clause 6.21D does not apply to development on land to which this clause applies.
