The object of these Rules is to amend Part 2 of Schedule E to the *Supreme Court Rules 1970* to provide that a registrar may make an order under section 110K of the *Supreme Court Act 1970* referring a matter for mediation or neutral evaluation only if the order is made by consent or is expressly unopposed.
