Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Nurses and Midwives Regulation 2008* so as to increase certain fees payable under the *Nurses and Midwives Act 1991* in respect of the registration and enrolment of nurses and midwives.

This Regulation is made under the *Nurses and Midwives Act 1991*, including section 78 (the general regulation-making power) and sections 18 (1), 19 (1), 24 (1), 27 (1), 28 and 33 (1) and (4).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Nurses and Midwives Amendment (Fees)* Regulation 2009.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Regulation (except for clause 3 (2)) commences on 1 May 2009 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
- (2) Clause 3 (2) commences on 1 June 2009.

3 Amendment of Nurses and Midwives Regulation 2008

(1) Schedule 3 Fees

Omit "\$80" wherever occurring in the matter relating to sections 18(1), 19(1), 24(1), 27(1), 28 and 33(4).

Omit "\$70" from the matter relating to section 33 (1).
