The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a filming project as a road event that may be the subject of a permit.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Roads Amendment (Filming) Regulation 2009.

Insert after clause 21:

Division 6 Road events

21A Filming projects

For the purposes of the definition of *road event* in the Dictionary to the Act, a filming project (within the meaning of the *Local Government Act 1993*), and any activity that is ancillary to or connected with such a filming project, is prescribed as a road event.
