under the

Motor Accidents Compensation Amendment Act 2009 No 26

- (a) sections 1 and 2,
- (b) Schedule 1 [2], [8]–[11] and [13]–[15].

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Motor Accidents Compensation Amendment Act 2009* that extend the bulk billing arrangements under the *Motor Accidents Compensation Act 1999* to all injured persons and that allow the variation of the period in respect of which contributions to the Motor Accidents Authority Fund are to be determined.
