Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to increase certain fees payable in relation to civil proceedings generally and certain other fees that are payable to the Sheriff, and
- (b) to consolidate in a single fee the fees:
 - (i) for filing an originating process for the winding up or reinstatement of a corporation under the *Corporations Act 2001* of the Commonwealth, and
 - (ii) for furnishing a sealed copy of the winding up or reinstatement order, and
- (c) to remove a fee for lodging a will as that fee is now provided for in clause 4 of the *Succession Regulation 2008*.

This Regulation is made under the Civil Procedure Act 2005, including section 18 (Fees).
