
Crimes (Appeal and Review) Amendment Act 2009 No 4

### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining uncommenced provision of the *Crimes (Appeal and Review) Amendment Act 2009*, which relates to the stay of a suspension or disqualification of a driver licence pending the determination of an appeal.
