

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence Schedules 1 and 22 to the Courts and Crimes Legislation Amendment Act 2008. Schedule 1 amends the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1995 and Schedule 22 amends the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulation 2006. The amendments relate to:

- (a) the legal recognition of persons who have undergone sex affirmation procedures and whose birth is not registered in New South Wales, and
- (b) the removal of redundant offences concerning the use of birth certificates by persons who have undergone sex affirmation procedures, and
- (c) the process of registering a change of sex.
