Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to declare the Consumer, Trader and Tenancy Tribunal to be a court for the purposes of Part 2A of the *Electronic Transactions Act 2000*.

This Regulation is made under the *Electronic Transactions Act 2000*, including sections 14A and 15 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

Clause 8 Definition of "court" for the purposes of Part 2A of the Act

Insert after clause 8 (2):

(3) The Consumer, Trader and Tenancy Tribunal is declared to be a court for the purposes of Part 2A of the Act.
