Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the number of demerit points incurred for disobeying a clearance or low clearance sign if the driver drives through or under (or attempts to drive through or under) a tunnel, bridge or other structure to which the sign relates. This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1998*, including sections 15 and 19 (the general regulation-making power).

Rule 102, but only where the driver drives through or under (or attempts to drive through or under) a tunnel, bridge or other structure to which a clearance sign or low clearance sign relates
