

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all the uncommenced provisions of the *Electricity and Gas Supply Legislation Amendment (Retail Price Disclosures and Comparisons) Act 2010.* Those provisions require the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal to publish electricity and gas retail pricing information on its website and require the websites of retail suppliers of electricity and suppliers of natural gas to contain a link to that website.
