Explanatory note

The Hunter New England Local Health District is a declared organisation under the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999* and may establish parking schemes within its area of operation.

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe two additional lots (Lots 1 and 99, DP 753848), being part of the Tamworth Base Hospital, as part of the area of operations of the Hunter New England Local Health District.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act* 1999, including section 71 (the general regulation-making power).
