Clause 4

4 Public holidays for a specified part of the State (section 5 (1) and (2))

A day or part-day specified in Column 2 is declared to be a public holiday for the part of the State specified in Column 1:

Walcha Council area	Half-day from 12 midday on 10 February 2012
That part of the County of Camden, the Parish of Cambewarra and those portions of the Parishes of Burrawang, Bugong, Yarrawa and Wallawa, situated within the Shoalhaven City Council area	17 February 2012
