Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to extend, until 31 December 2012, the trial period in which JusticeLink (an electronic case management system established under the *Electronic Transactions Act 2000*) is authorised to be used as an on-line court in relation to committal proceedings in the Local Court heard at the Downing Street Centre that are conducted in the absence of the public in accordance with section 56 (3) of the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986*. This Order is made under clause 3 of Schedule 1 to the *Electronic Transactions Act 2000*.
