Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Building Professionals Regulation 2007* to enable accredited certifiers who hold Category A1, A2 or A3 accreditations to issue certain certificates with respect to the demolition or removal of buildings.

This Regulation is made under the *Building Professionals Act 2005*, including sections 5A (2), 6 and 94 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
