Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase (from \$116 to \$119) the fee that is payable under the *Succession Act 2006* for depositing a will in the office of the Registrar of the Supreme Court.

This Regulation is made under the *Succession Act 2006*, including sections 51 (3) and 143 (the general regulation-making power).
