Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to provide that the specified policies of professional indemnity insurance of Vero Insurance and Allianz Australia Limited are approved by the Minister for Innovation and Better Regulation from 1 July 2015 until 30 June 2016 for the purposes of clause 6 (2) (a) of the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 2006*, which requires a licensee to be insured under an approved policy.
